Supplier Diversity (SD) is a business practice that is growing in recognition among top Canadian businesses. SD means making supply chains inclusive and buying from businesses owned and operated by historically disadvantaged persons.

Supporters of Supplier Diversity include big business and governments across Canada. By registering as a Diverse Supplier you will increase opportunities to do business with them.

How it works

- 1 Get certified with a Supply Council.**
This is important because large corporations rely on third party non-profit Supply Councils to do preliminary vetting.
- 2 We'll include you in a Diverse Supplier directory.**
Top companies search these directories when they are looking for new suppliers.
- 3 Register for events to build your network.**
Events by IWSCC and partners are your opportunity to meet procurement staff from large businesses. A receptive audience will mean you can quickly and easily gain inside knowledge about how the goods and services that you provide are typically procured and who to contact.

Who qualifies?

The Inclusive Workplace and Supply Council of Canada certifies firms owned by either Veterans or persons with disabilities. Qualifying businesses are at least 51% owned, managed and controlled by one or more persons with a disability, or one or more Veterans.
